

Foxhangers Moorings Guidelines

The following is a user-friendly guide for all moorers and visitors of some key points to ensure that the Foxhangers moorings remain peaceful and enjoyable for everyone.

All Visitors

Dogs

We ask that dogs are kept on leads whilst on the roads and paths around Lower Foxhangers. Please do not exercise dogs in the surrounding fields.

In order to avoid distressed and barking dogs, please do not leave dogs unattended on-board any boat.

Access to towpath on foot

Access is permitted to the Kennet & Avon Canal towpath at the lock 22 canal bridge via the styles and short path through the field. Please keep to the direct route between the styles.

Car parking

Space is limited so each mooring is restricted to a maximum of 2 cars (commercial vehicles are not allowed to be parked on site). If short term additional spaces are required, please contact reception. Always park considerately, leaving sufficient space for large emergency vehicles or machinery to pass.

If you leave cars when out on your boat, please park them in the hire boat car park, contact reception for combination number to the gate.

Site speed limit

The maximum acceptable speed limit on the site is 10mph.

The Moorings

Electric

We endeavour to maintain a reliable electrical supply; however, this cannot be guaranteed, and short outages may occur. Each 240v outlet can provide a maximum load of 16 amp and is protected accordingly.

The electric usage on all berths is metered and charged accordingly per KW on your bill.

Pump out

Is available by arrangement at Foxhangers Wharf, please call the office to arrange a time for a member of staff to attend to your pump-out. Alternatively, Caen Hill Marina offer public pump-out service.

Water

Taps are available at each mooring, there is no charge for water, but supply is limited especially at peak times, when a fill that usually would take 20 mins can take up to 3 hours.

We would be grateful if you can avoid filling your water tanks on Friday, Saturday & Monday mornings from April to November when the hire boat turnarounds are being carried out.

Post and deliveries

The use of Foxhangers for post and deliveries is not permitted.

Maintenance and minor repairs

Moorers are permitted to do minor maintenance and repairs to their boat whilst on the mooring, with the proviso that no disruption or impact is caused to fellow moorers. Third party maintenance and repairs work must be carried out by Foxhangers staff or Foxhangers approved contractors. Contact reception for further information.

Appearance

All boats should be kept in a tidy and presentable condition.

Storage

Owners possessions must be kept on board except the linear moorings that have written permission to erect a shed alongside their mooring.

Unreasonable behaviour

For the comfort of our other moorers, noise must be kept to a minimum between hours of 8pm and 7am. This includes the running of engines and generators. Unreasonable behaviour of any kind should be brought to the attention of Foxhangers' management. In extreme cases, the offender may be required to vacate their mooring.

If you require any further clarification, please visit us at reception which is located by the farmhouse and open Monday to Friday 8am-6pm, Saturday 9am-5pm. (Closed on Saturdays in December – February).
